CCTA offers several programs designed to meet the needs of your school community:

Broadway Kids: Students work with a professional director and musical director to perform a full musical production including professional costumes, scenery and live musicians. Ten one-hour sessions.

From Page To Stage: Students work with a professional musical director and drama educator to write their own original work based on a developmental asset important to your school. This ten-week program culminates in a performance of students' original work.

Acting 101: Students learn the fundamentals of acting and begin to build a theatrical vocabulary in a small group setting. Ten one-hour sessions.

Improv: The Art of Impulse: Students work with a professional improv director and performer to create their own improvisational theater piece. Focus is on strategy, form and vocabulary related to this theatrical form. Ten one-hour sessions.
